- You need to be at the AB&E Volunteer Headquarters based in the First United Methodist Church at 320 W. 7th Street at 2:30PM on Monday September 5th. Make adjustments for parking and travel in your timetable.
- You can park at Royal Oak High School and take the shuttle in to the event. There is a stop right next to the church.
- When we meet at Headquarters, in the basement, at 2:30 for the quick training session, 4 people will be separated for Information Booth training at that time. If someone needs to sit down at all, this would be a good spot for him or her, as you can sit in the info booth, but your not supposed to sit at the gates.
- We will be divided into teams for each gate at this meeting. We will keep you and your friends together to work at a gate. AB&E will provide us with training on taking tickets and attaching wristbands.
- Shade is on a per gate basis
- Meal coupons handed out at the meeting. Meals will be more centrally located on Washington between 5th and 6th streets. Volunteers can eat their meal in the basement of Headquarters.
- -Shuttle runs from ROHS to the festival until 4:30am each night. Begins about 8:30/9. Two pick up locations are at Volunteer Headquarters and at 2nd/Washington.
- -ABE's will supply every volunteer with 2 bottles of water that they can take to the gate and there will be coolers at the gate with extra water in it.
